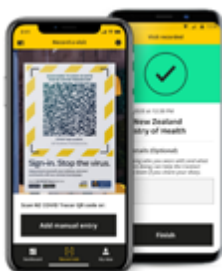

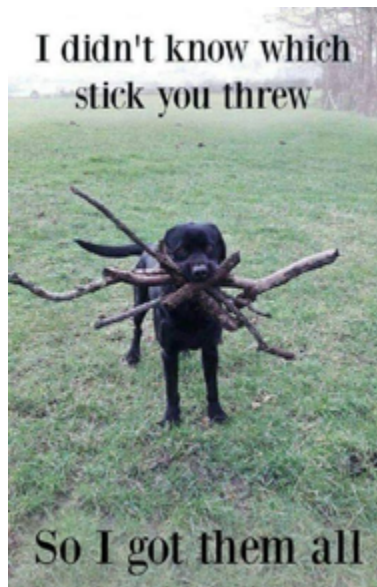

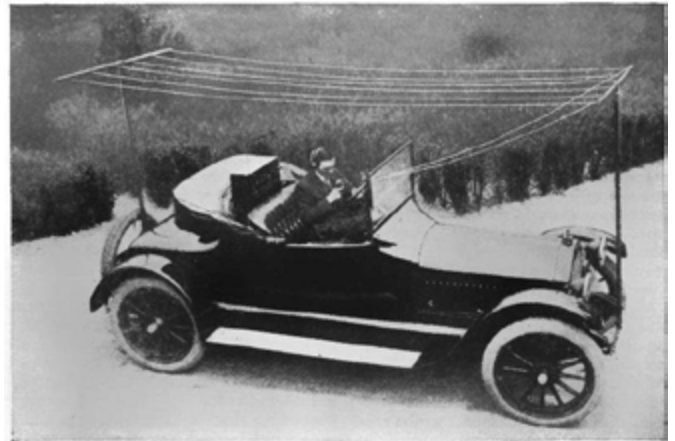
1958 Sir Vival. A two piece concept car created by Walter C. Jerome on mission to make the world's safest car.
